

About anti-Semitic Jews and anti-Zionist Israelies

Years ago, in the subways of New York a manufacturer of rye bread placed advertising posters, where you could see, for example, an Eskimo eating bread, and below was written, You don't have to be Jewish to like it.

Today we could put up posters in the universities of Israel and the world with the phrase You Can Be Jewish and hate Jews, Being Jewish, or being a son or daughter of a Jew, is not an obstacle to be anti-Semitic. On the contrary, there is no worse anti-Semite than an anti-Semitic Jew. Nor is there a worse anti-Zionist than an anti-Zionist Jew, even if he/she was born and/or lives in Israel. And this is nothing new. In Spain, from the 13th to the 15th century, those that most persecuted Jews, were Jewish renegades and apostates. Today, the leaders of the campaign against Israel, accusing it of being an apartheid country, neo-nazi, genocide, war criminal, colonial, illegitimate, with no right to exist, are Jews, including Israeli and former Israeli. Some go so far as to justify denying the Holocaust.

Israeli universities are full of anti-Zionist academics that propagate their hate and have no qualms about using pressure and threat of bad grades to force students to follow in their footsteps. They advocate the liquidation of the state of Israel and its replacement by a single state with an Arab majority. They write books and articles calling for Israel to be boycotted, including the institutions that pay their salary. They understand, sympathize and justify the atrocities that the Palestinians have committed against Israeli civilians. For them "there is no good Israeli nor a bad Palestinian."

Uzi Silber, in his article "The Jew Flu: The strange illness of Jewish anti-Semitism", wrote that the Jewish anti-Semite "feels more the pain of members of an alien group than the pain of his own group, feeling that metamorphoses into a moral and emotional identification with people whose goal is to exterminate him. "

It is common to accuse them of self hate, but this is wrong because usually such a person is very pleased with himself/herself, is narcissistic, and if he/she has a complex, it is a superiority complex. They boast of being "the true representatives of the Jewish ethic," and are proud to be quoted by anti-Semitic non-Jews as an example of "those Jews who think like us."

They hate the other Jews and the Jewish state, driven by ultra-leftist convictions, their identification with the Palestinians and their desire to be accepted into a world where there is little sympathy for the Jews. It is a variation of the Stockholm syndrome, identifying themselves with the enemies of the Jews.

The Jews today, as the Jews since biblical times, are fighting for their existence. Anti-Semitic Jews are a fifth column that threatens the survival of Israel and Jewish communities worldwide.
